
SESE:History

Science



- Last week, you were learning about different types of sounds. You experimented with making sounds that were high, low, loud and quiet.
- Imagine you were going to the zoo. You would hear lots of sounds there. Close your eyes and imagine what you could hear?
- Can you draw three of your favourite sounds that you could hear? Don't forget to write what kind of sound it is beside your picture.





 Here are some activities that you could try at home to learn more about sound. You can choose one or try them all throughout the week, your choice!

Fill five glasses/jars up with different levels of water.
Tap each jar with a spoon, what sounds did they make? Did each glass/jar make a different sound?
Ask an adult to gather the glasses and be very careful when tapping the glass!

Fill a plastic bottle up with rice and close it with the lid. Shake the bottle, what can you hear? Explore ways to make the bottle sound louder and quieter. *You can always paint the bottle and you have your very own music shaker!*

Cover a plastic bowl with some cling film. Pour a small amount of rice onto the cling film. Hold a baking tray close to the bowl and using a spoon, hit the tin. What happens to the rice? Why do you think that happens?


Do we need Rules?

Aim: Recognise and become familiar with the rules within a group or wider community, those who safeguard these rules, and the importance of obeying the rules in order to keep people safe.

Ask your child to tell you about the school rules.


Discuss the rules -

- Is X a good rule?
- What would happen if the children didn't obey the rule?
- Why does Mr. Morris have rules?
- Then ask them to think about what other places might have rules(e.g. library, The Square, the park)
- Discuss these rules and their importance and how they are there to keep us safe.
- Ask your child to think of people who help them- People at home, school, on way to school, people in the area
- ➤ Discuss the importance of these people and the rules they may have for keeping us safe.

Sunflowers by Van Gogh



Time to create your own Sunflowers.



You will need:

- yellow paper, green paper & brown paper
 (or colour/paint some paper green, brown & yellow)
- glue
- tape
- scissors
- Optional: sunflower seeds to decorate the center.

Step 1: Yellow paper-

- Fold the yellow sheet of paper in half and cut it.
- Start folding the paper make an accordion fold
- Fold all the way to the end of the sheet.
- When done, fold in half And glue together.
- Repeat with the other half of the yellow sheet of paper. Glue both halves together.

Step 2: Brown paper-

 Cut a smaller circle out of brown paper. Glue it onto your sunflower rosette.

Step 3: Green paper-

- Roll the green paper to make the stem and glue it in place.
 Cut leaves out of green paper and glue them onto the stem.
- Apply glue to the stem.
 Press the sunflower rosette on the stem.
- Secure with tape at the back




