- An adult to help sometimes!





WEDNESDAY – CHARACTER DESCRIPTION

- In a story we always have characters.
- It is important that in a story we describe the characters using adjectives.
- Remember: adjectives are describing words for example – fluffy, hard, large, smooth.
- When we are describing characters we need to describe two things:
 1. What they look like on the outside: tall, hairy, pretty
 2. What they look like on the inside: funny, shy, helpful, forgetful, kind
- In the next slide you will see a picture of the character you will all know. Imagine an alien has come to earth and you have to describe this character to them now write your description.
- Include what they look like on the outside and inside and make sure to say how you know they are like that on the inside. Then draw your own picture of this character.


