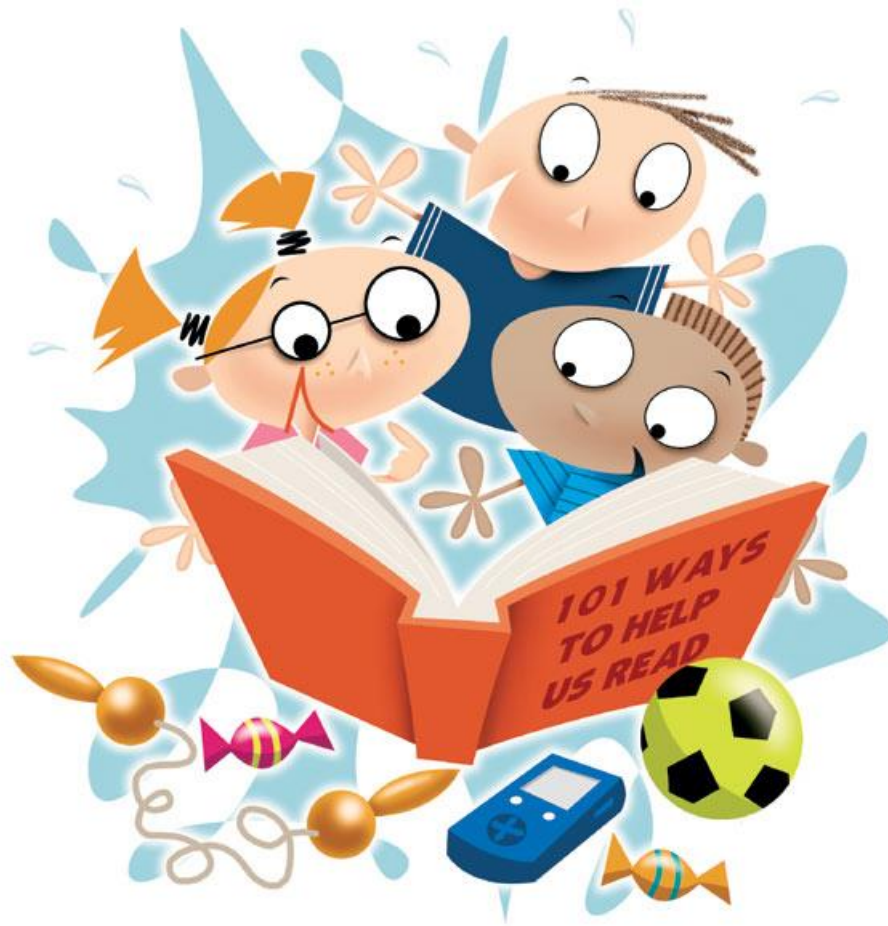










Check your child's pencil grip is correct.

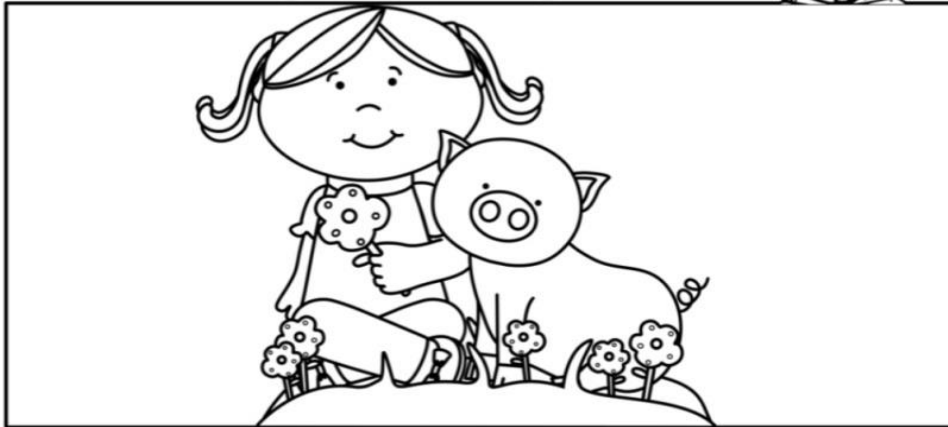

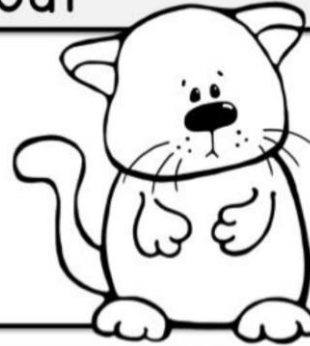
