



Before reading

Talk together

Look at the cover. Ask: Do you think the boy's dad can do a handstand, too?

Story words

These words may be challenging but they are important for the story. Read them together and talk about what they mean.

play - to use a musical instrument (p3), or to have fun (p9)

honk - the loud sound that a horn makes (pl2)

catch - to grab something that is flying through the air (pI3, I6)

After reading

- Invite your child to retell the story in their own words. Encourage them to look back at the pictures if they need to and prompt them if necessary.
- Look at the picture on p4 and ask: Why do you think Dad is holding his ears? (Answer: e.g. because the drum is too loud.)
- Read p8 of the story again. Ask: Why is Zac 'the best'? (Answer: e.g. because Zac won the game.)
- Look at the pictures on pI6 and ask: How do you think Zac feels about his dad at the end of the story?
