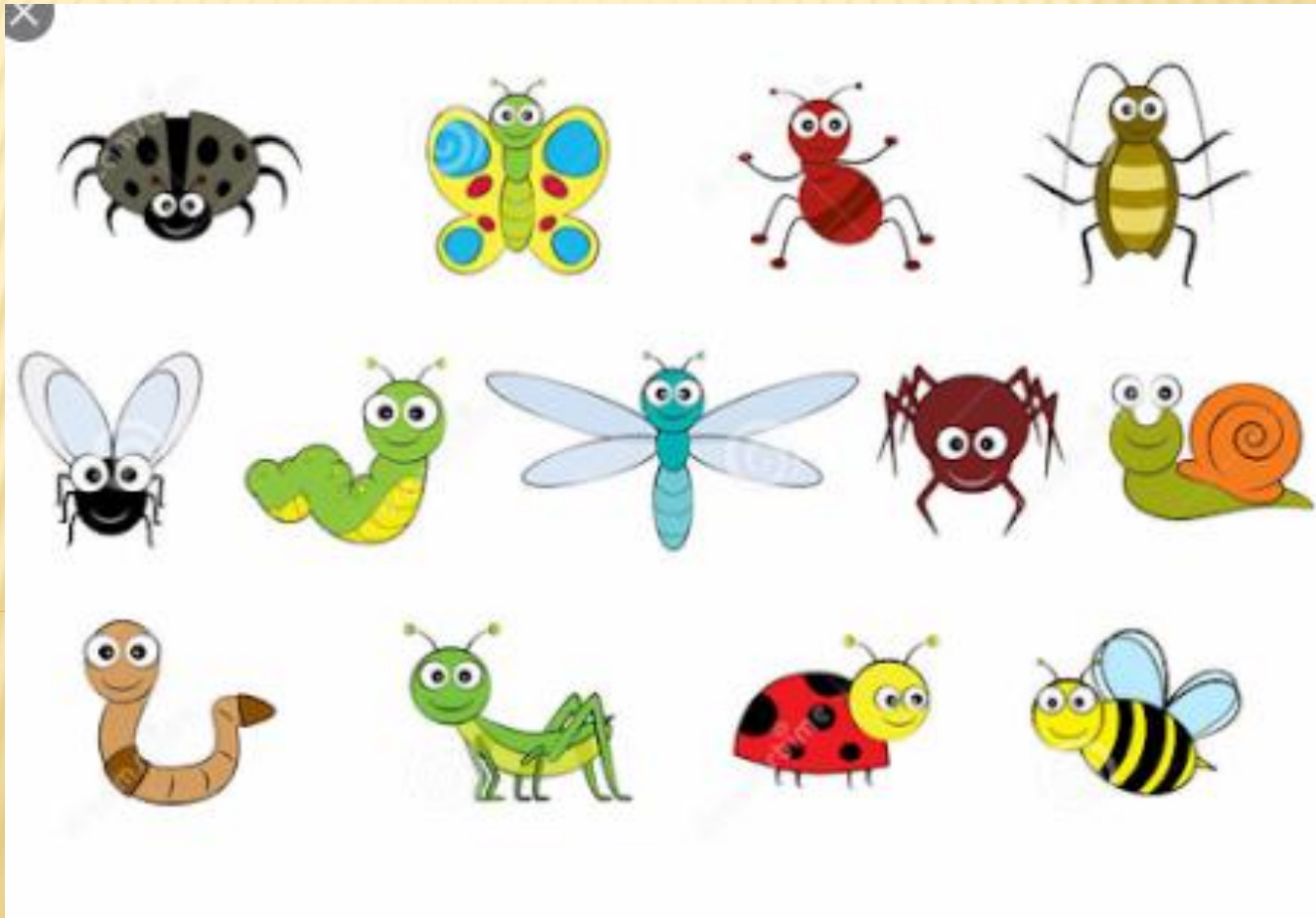

FUN FACTS ABOUT MINI-BEASTS

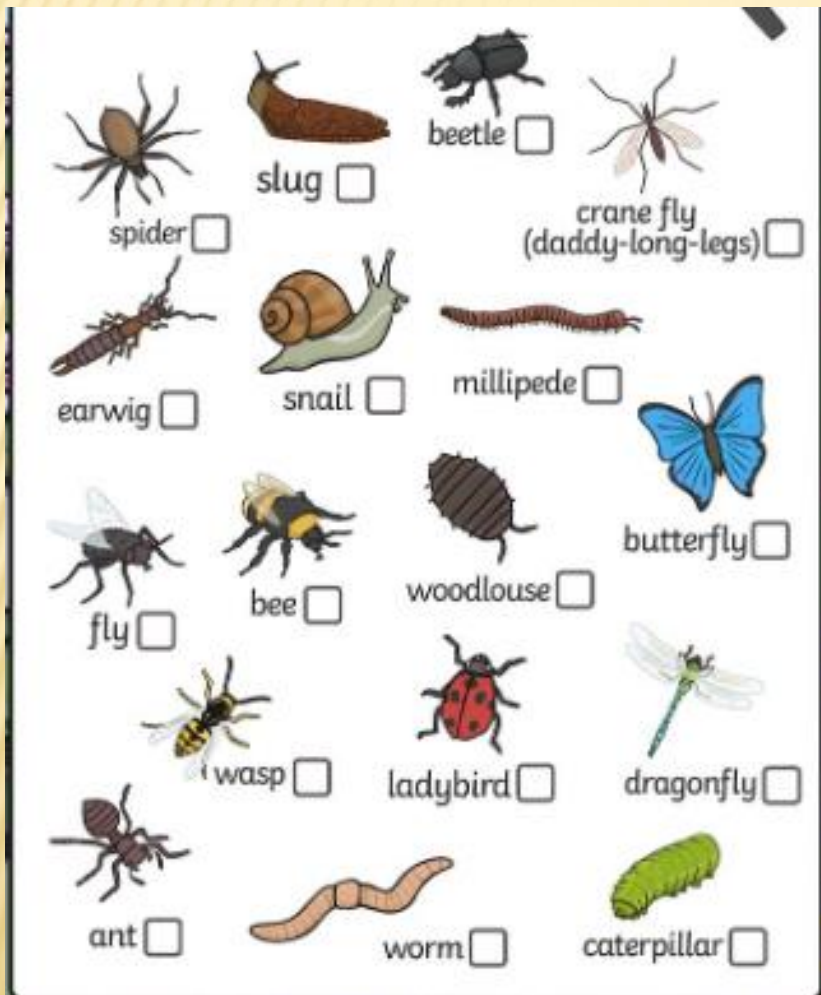
- ✗ Mini-beasts roam in the trees and grass of your garden or backyard.
