

FUN FACTS ABOUT MINI-BEASTS


- ✘ Mini-beasts roam in the trees and grass of your garden or backyard.






Some of the insects already have some of their legs so you will need to add the pegs to make the total number of legs that they need.




STORYTIME


- ✘ Children you have listened to the story of The Hungry Caterpillar in class so now you can watch an animated film using this link:
