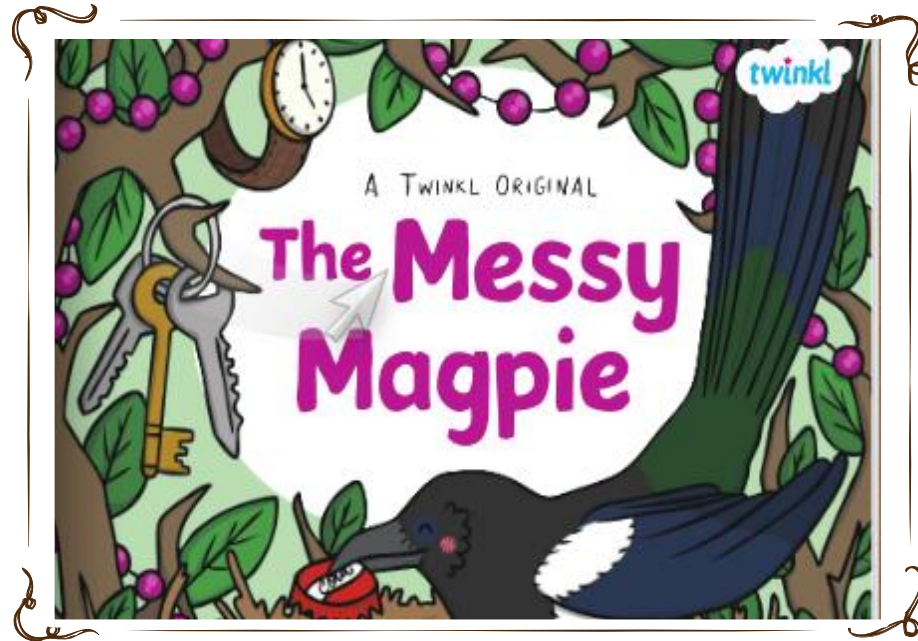
Taking care of my world.

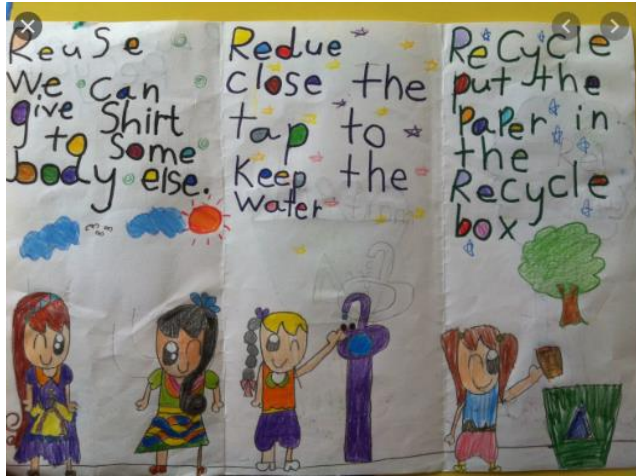
Now that you have finished your walk – Listen to the story of The Messy Magpie.

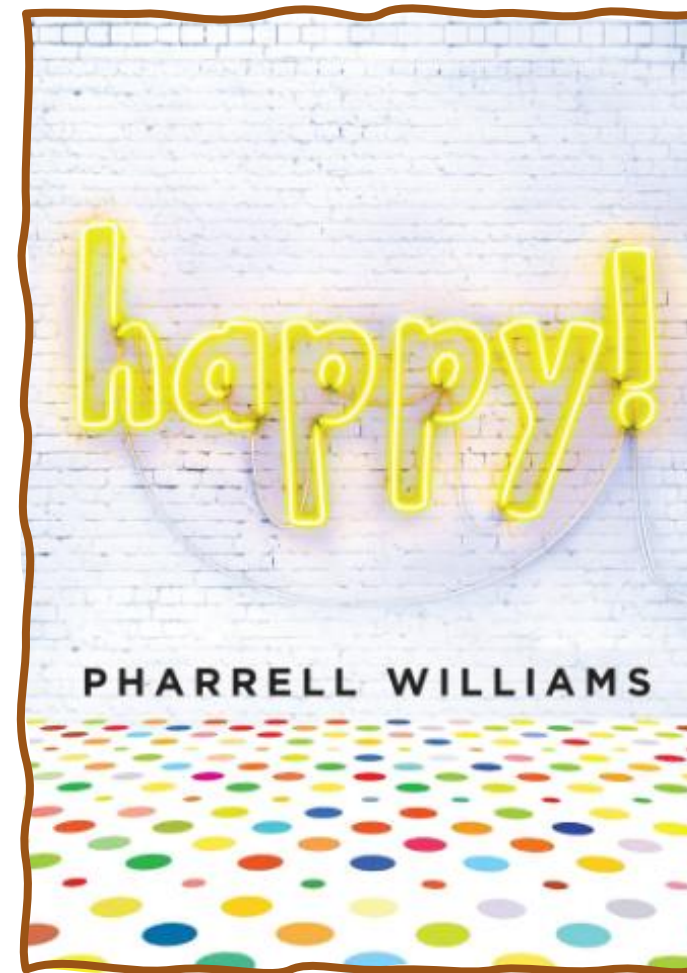

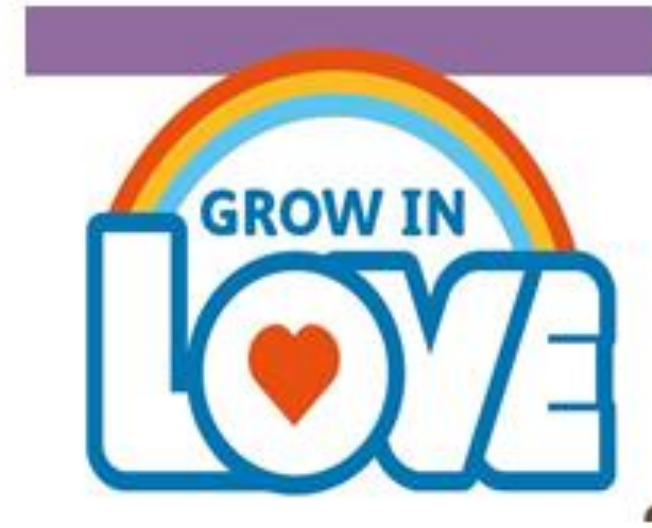

Have you ever seen a May altar before?

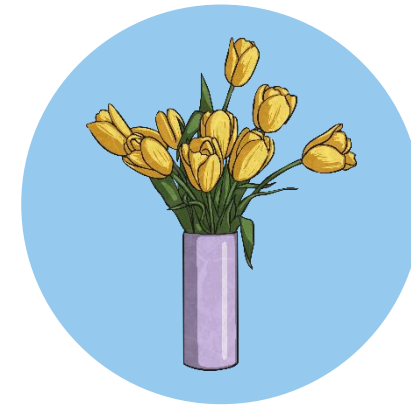


What Can We Put on Our May Altar?
