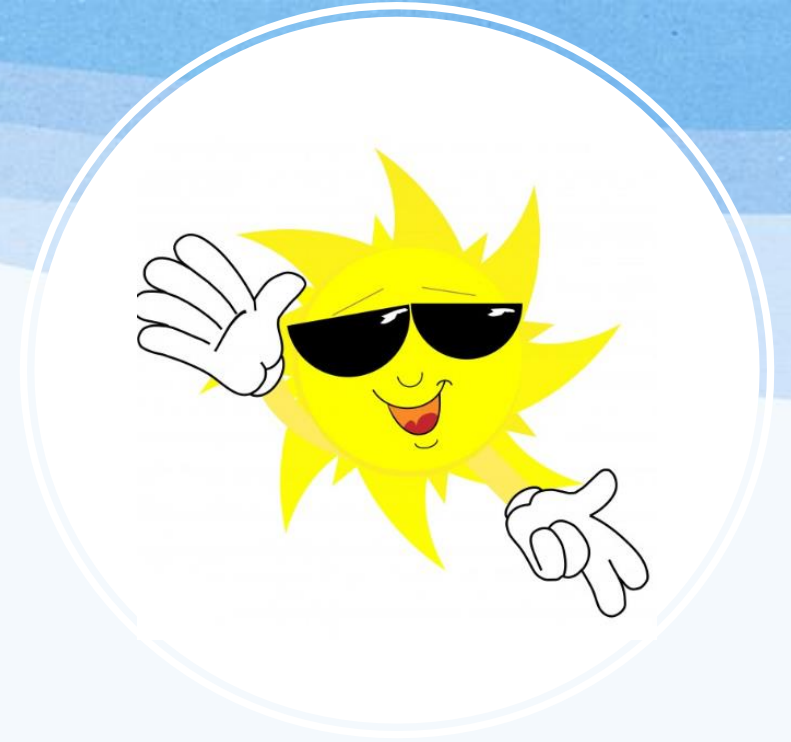

Aim: Begin to be sensitive to the feelings of others and to realise that the actions of one individual can affect the feelings of another.

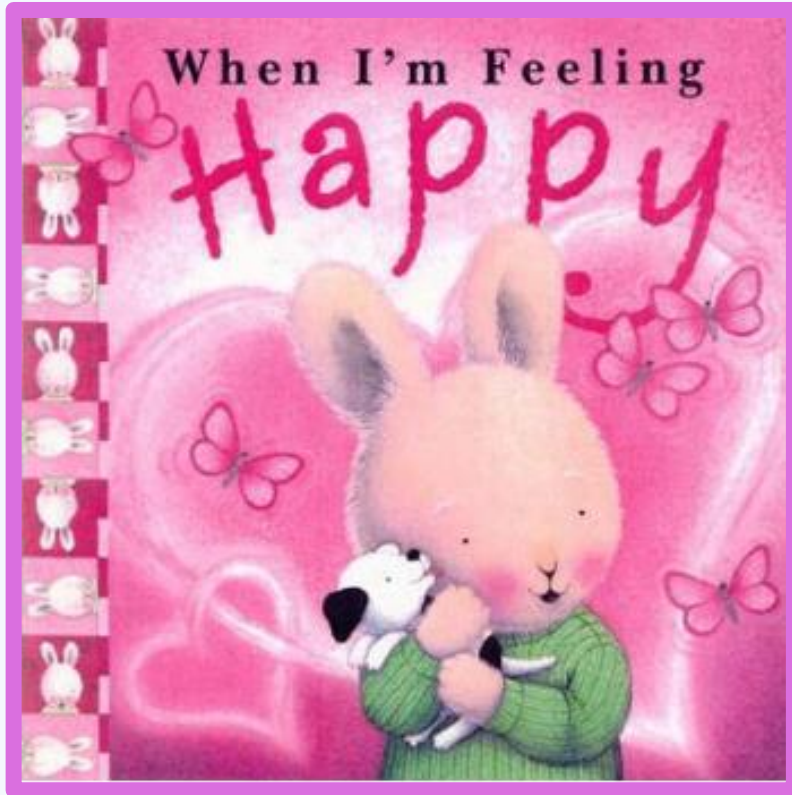


This week I want you to think about things that make you **happy** 😊

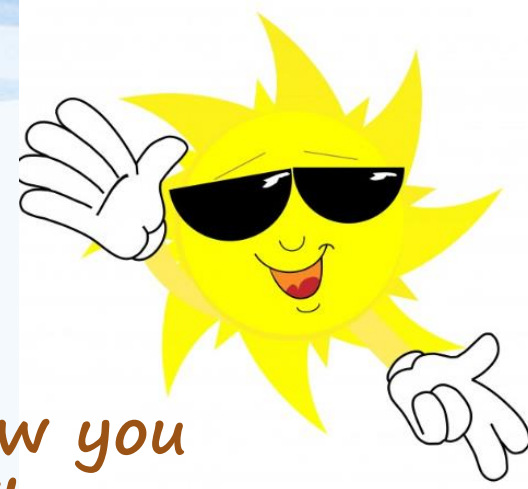
What makes you happy?

- You have done great thinking about all the people and things that make you happy.



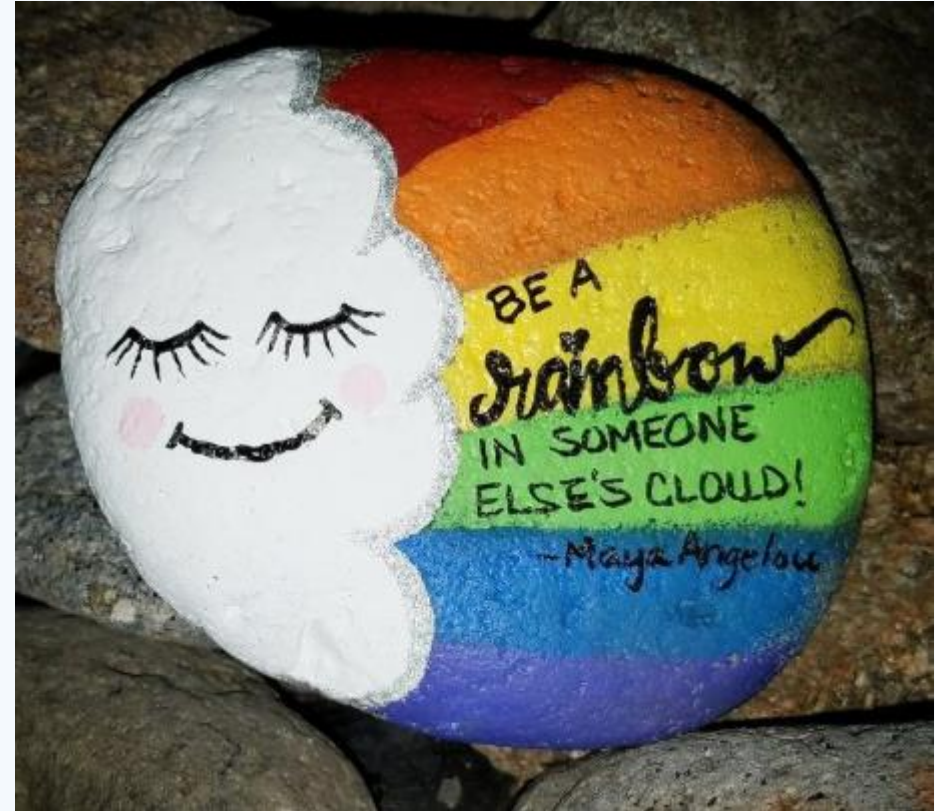
- ❖ Now think about how you can make your family **happy**?

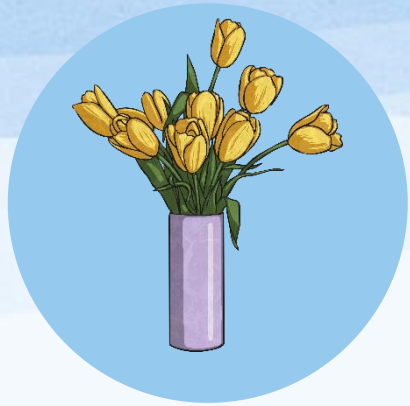
