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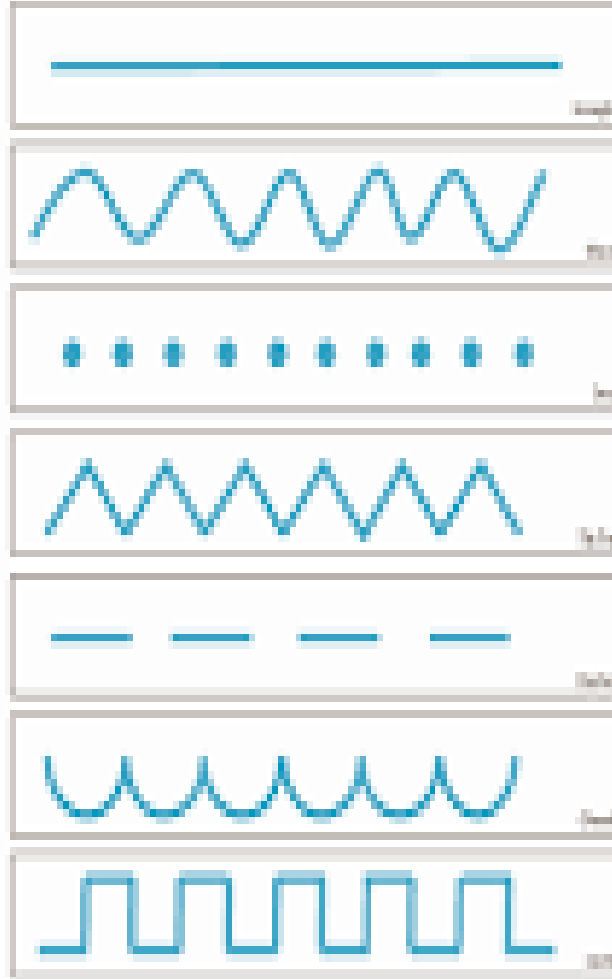

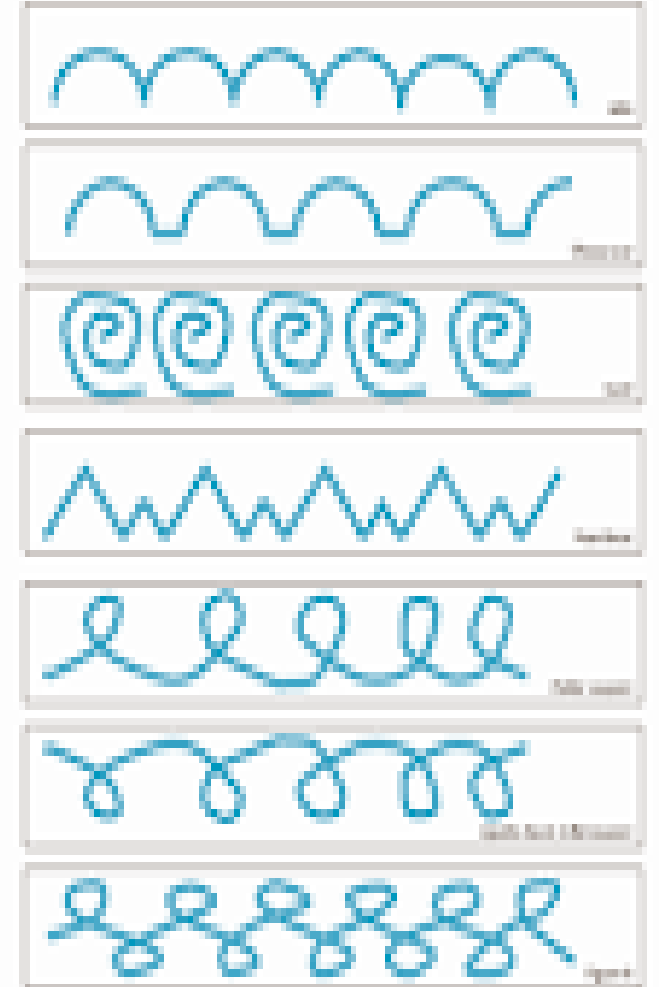
Practice makes perfect!

Fluency Patterns

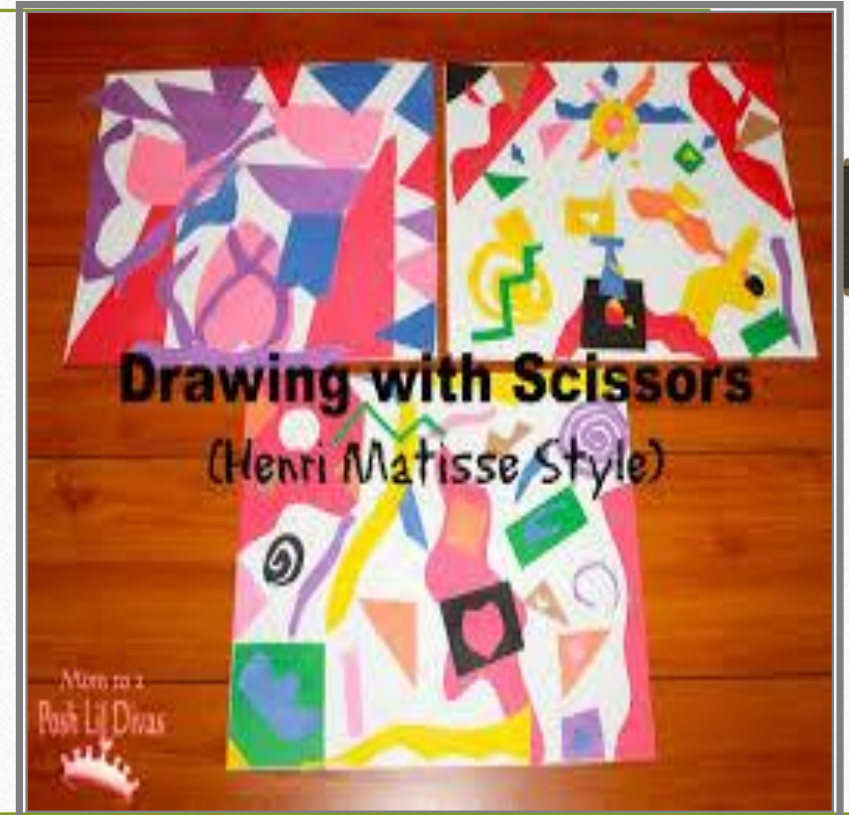

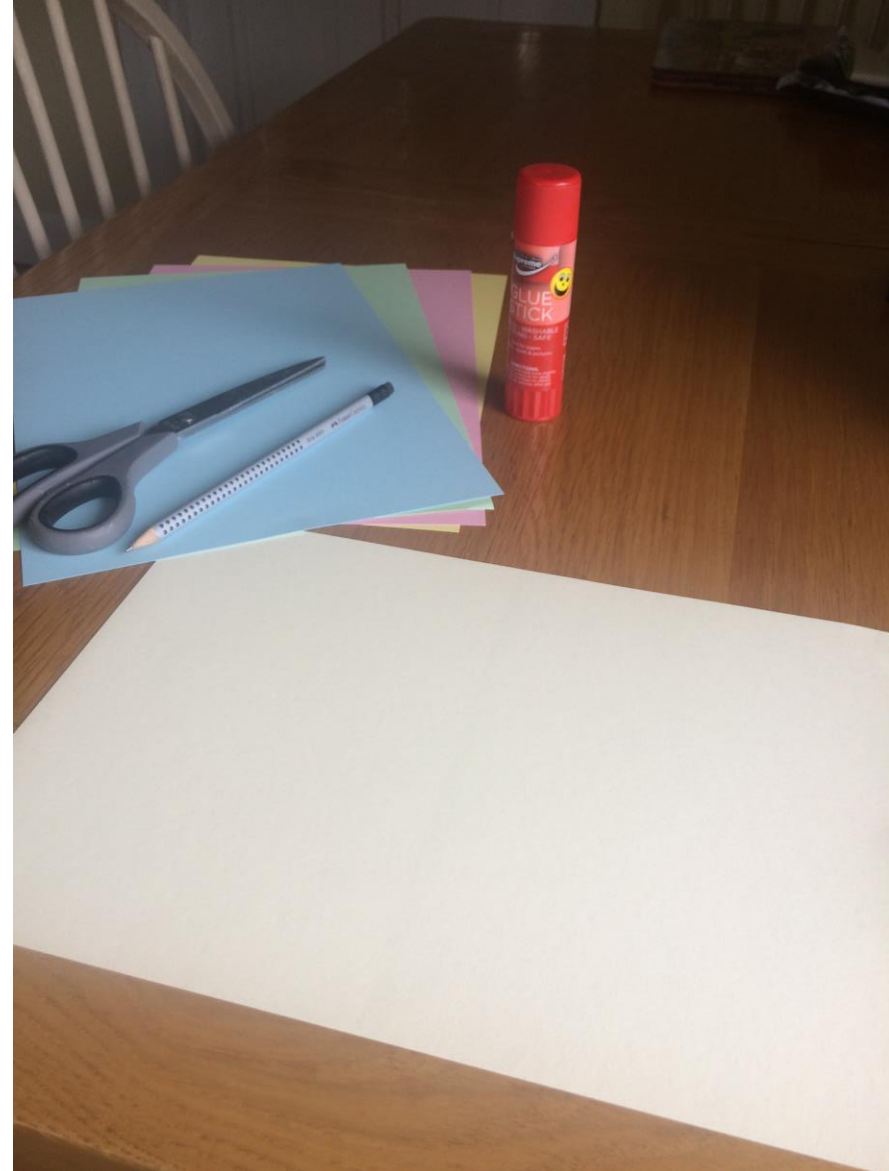
Be as Creative as You Like!

- If you Google Matisse 'collages' you will find lots and lots of images to give you some inspiration for your art this week. The good thing is you can use these as an example or you can use your **own imagination**. It is totally up to you what kind of **shapes, sizes, colours** and **types of paper** you would like to use. It doesn't even have to be anything in particular it's all about making different **shapes and colours**!



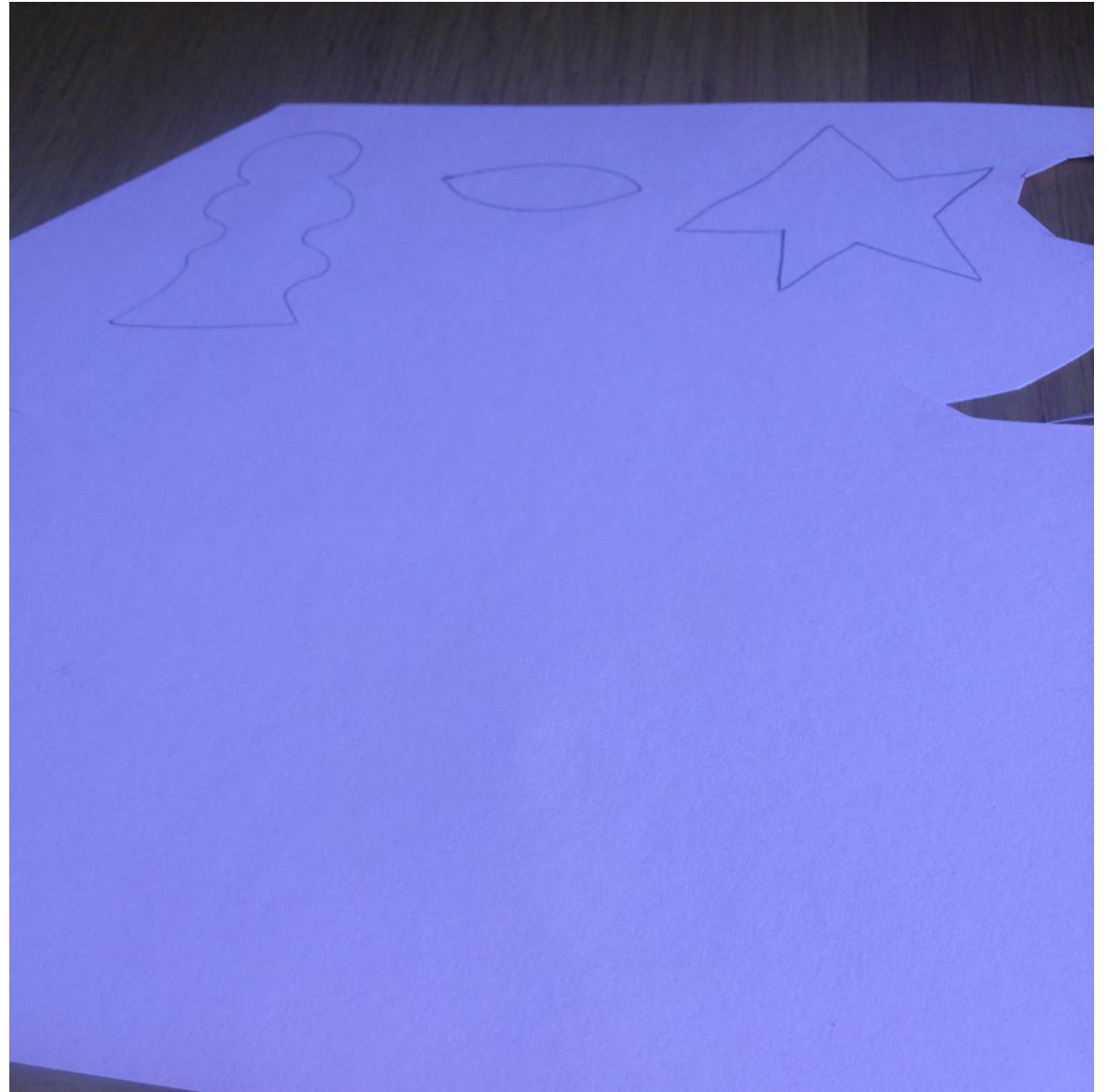
Step 1:

- Gather the materials you would need to complete your collage.
- Ask an adult to help when you are using the scissors!



Step 2:

- Try your best to draw some of the shapes first before cutting them out if you prefer.
- Make sure to get an adult to help you with the drawing and cutting.



Step 3:

- Cut out all the shapes you would like.
- Now think about how you want to decorate your collage and decide where you want to put them before you start gluing.





Step 4:

I decided where I wanted to place each of the shapes before I glued each shape down one at a time

Step 5:

- Once you have glued all your shapes down why not choose a title for your art.
- Try your best to write the title of your picture and your name by yourself. Of course ask an adult or your older brother or sister to help!

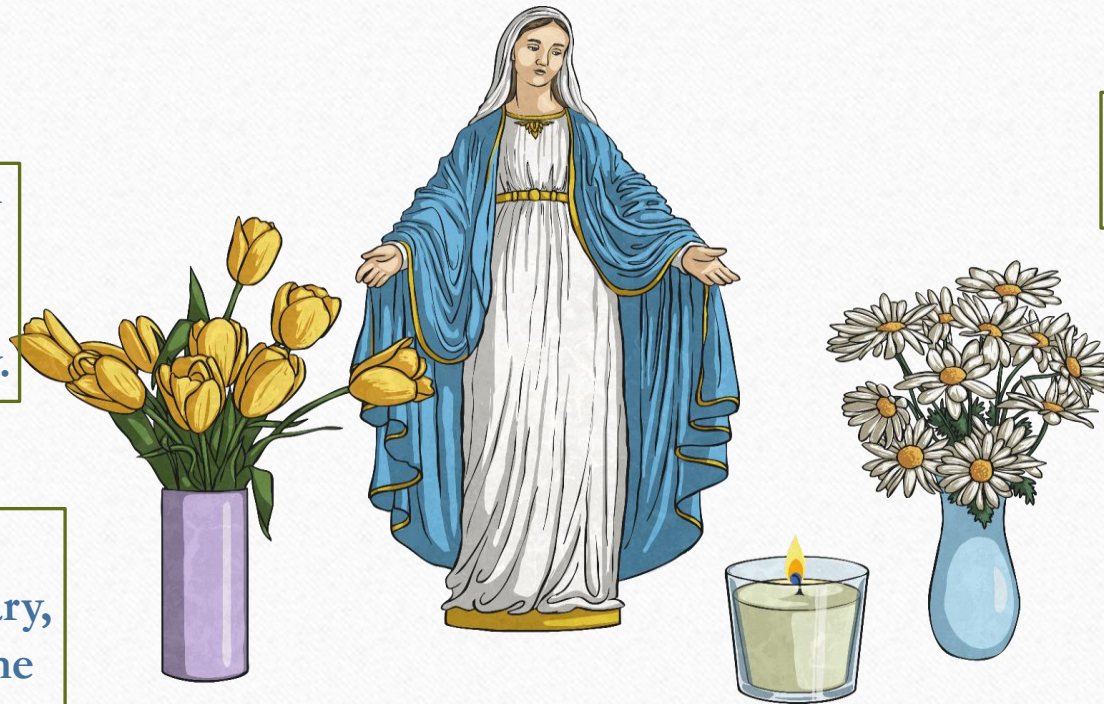
