This week we have a book for you to read about the zoo. Click on the pictures and listen to the sentences. Say the sentences when you have heard them.

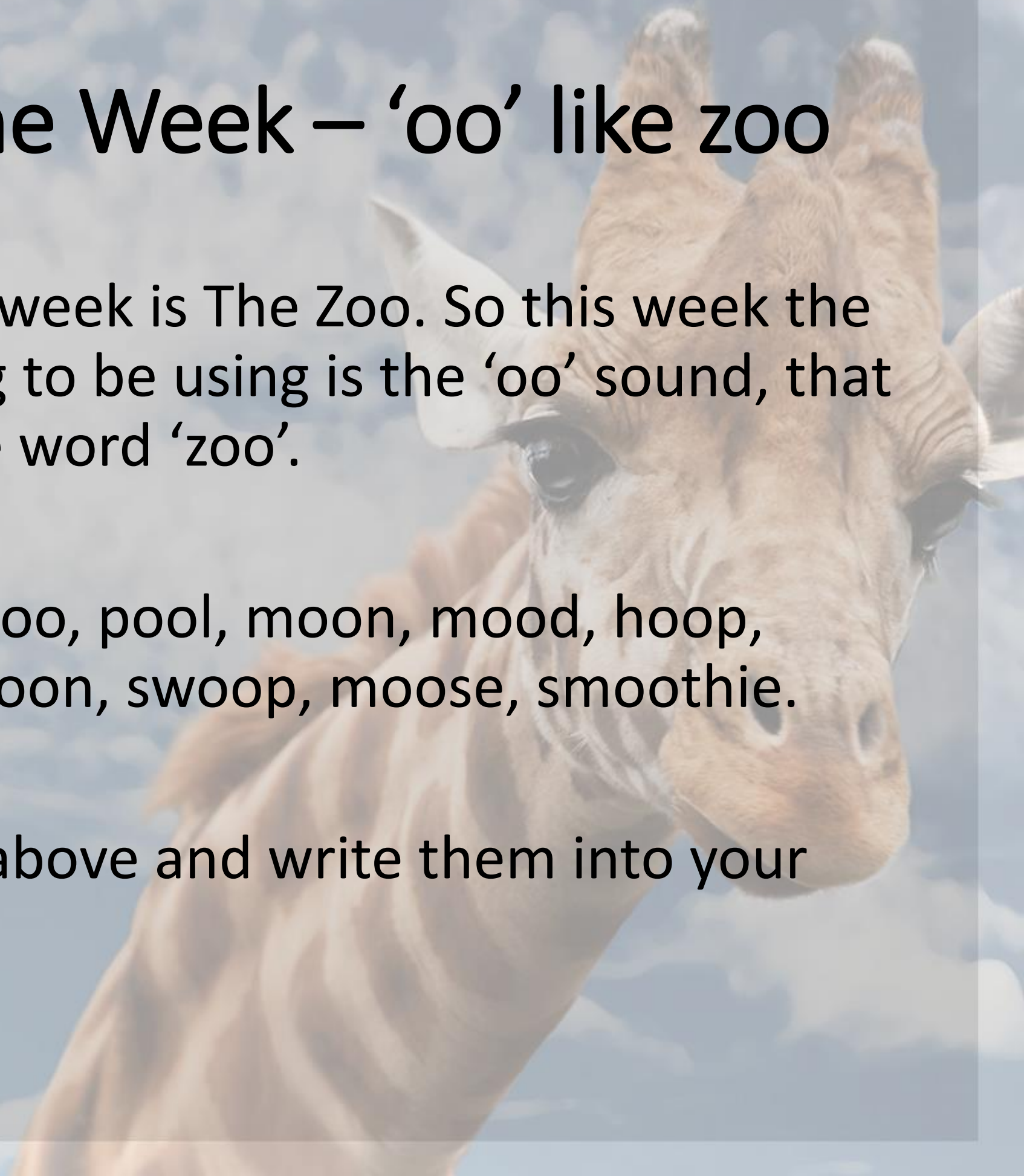

Sound of the Week – ‘oo’ like zoo

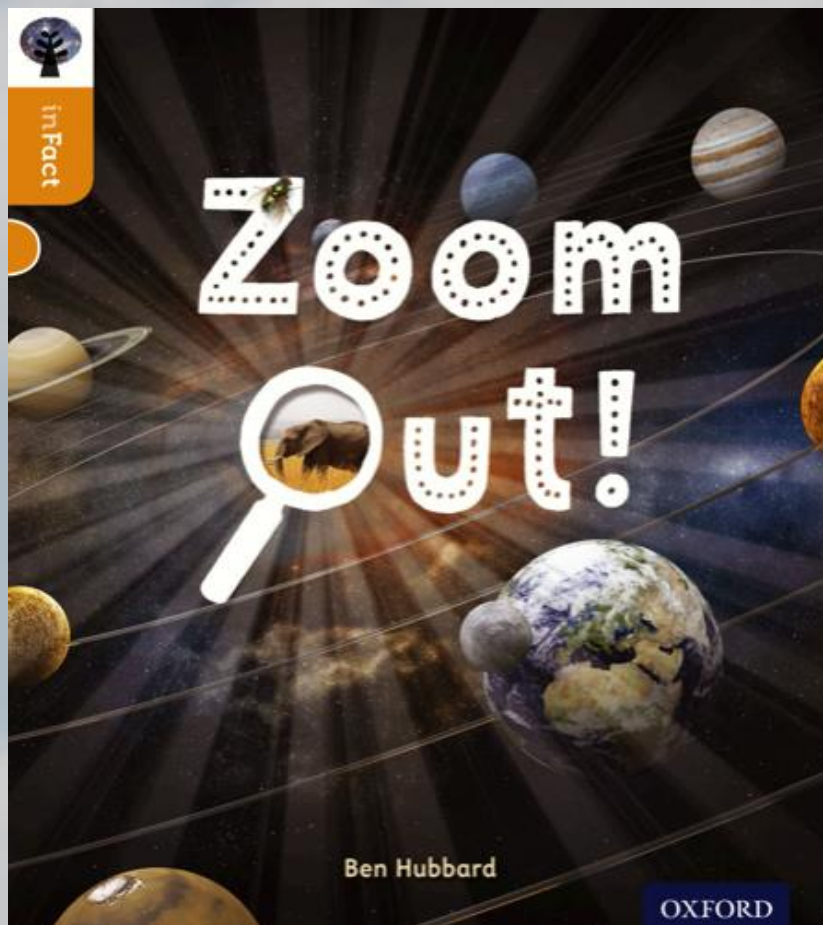

Tricky Reading

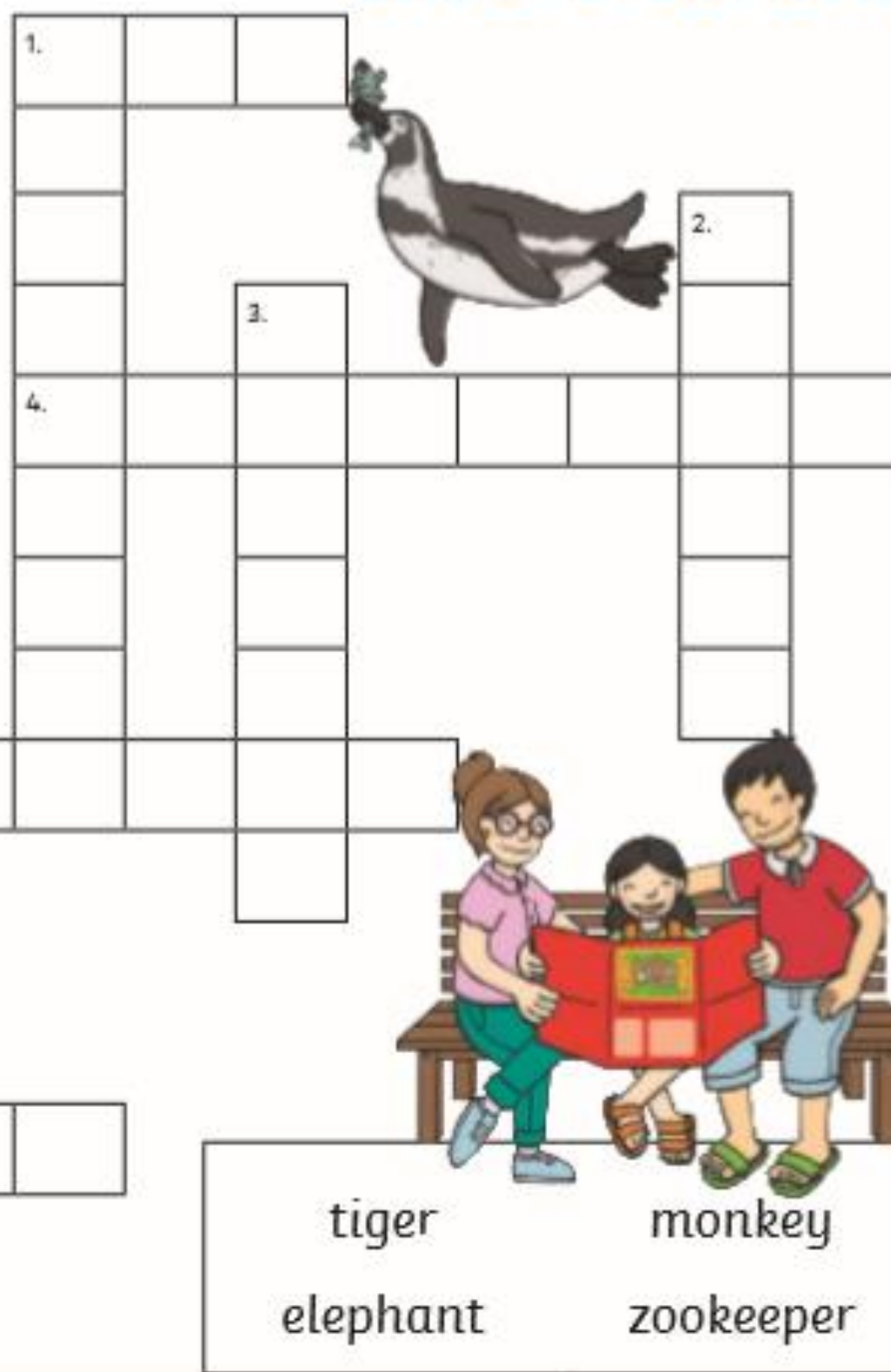
On the **Oxford Owl** website there is a book '**Zoom Out!**' We recommend you read this book this week as it has lots of 'oo' words in the story. You can find it here:

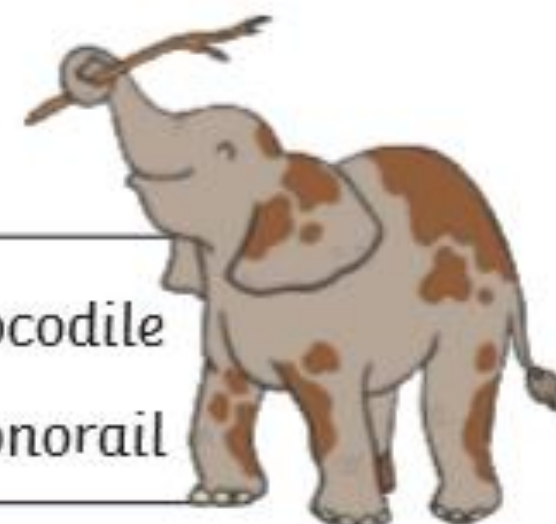
