Down in the Jungle...



What is your favourite jungle animal?

- Describe it: colour, size:big/small,how it moves, what does it eat, what sound does it make?
- Draw a picture.

What do you see?

- You can make your very own binoculars.
- You will need cardboard tubes(inserts of toilet roll/kitchen roll),a stapler, colours or stickers to decorate it, string to tie around your neck.
- Ask an adult to staple the tubes together. You can decorate it if you want to?
- Use your binoculars to see what you can find. You can use these anywhere. Draw what you see.



In the Jungle,the Mighty Jungle

- If you have plastic jungle animals,set them up along with plastic trees,sticks,twigs,rocks.You could add bowls of water and maybe some soil too.
- Arrange and play with the animals in their different habitats e.g. the hippopotomus in the bowl of water,the giraffe near the tree or twig.





Snake Painting



What you need: string (like twine), shallow trays of paint, paper and clothes pegs which are optional.

Drag the string through the paint and then drag it onto the paper.

You can use the clothes peg on the string to make it easier to hold.

You can mix colours to see what new ones you create.

What will you call your snake?



Jungle Drums



- Create your own drums using different recyclable materials such as porridge containers, coffee tins, boxes, pringle crisps boxes etc.
- Explore the different sounds .What animal would match the sound?
- Make different patterns, hard/soft, 2 taps, 4 taps...



Jungle Vine Gross Motor

Pull some chairs together and thread some green crepe paper through to make some jungle vines to crawl through.

This will encourage lots of imaginative play.

Make your own snakes with some of the crepe paper.

Use your binoculars to see what animals you can find on your adventure.

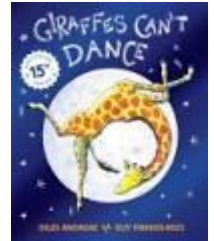
