



Q1Point to (or draw) the longest object in each question.









I have **no** corners and I have 1 side. What am I??


I have 4 corners, 4 sides that are **all the same length**! What am I??

I have 4 corners and 4 sides. 2 sides are long and 2 sides are short. What am I??







Number Pairs to 5 Join the pairs of numbers that add up to 5.




Add 1 Draw one more. How many are there now?









How Many Are Under The Bowl ?




If struggling start with fewer counters and if finding it easy try 6/7 counters.

End of Year Test Time!!


- Show your child the numbers 0-10 and check if they recognise them
- Ask your child to count from 1 and check how far they can count with no mistakes
- Ask them to count backwards from 10 or 5
- Call out the numbers 0-5 and ask your child to write them down
- Check if your child can match the correct number to the correct amounts within 10
