The sun will shine, you'll run outside -

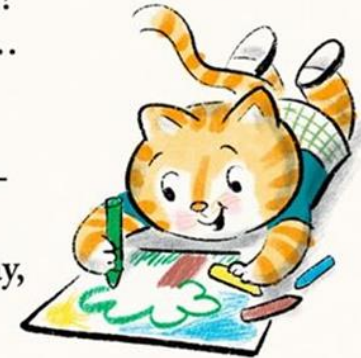
"Just look at how I've grown!" you'll say,

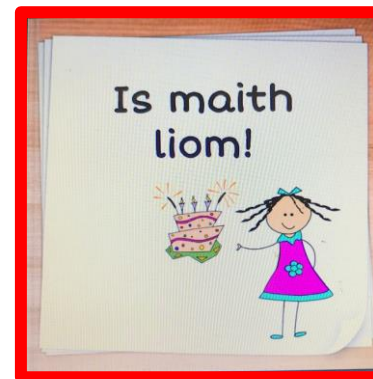


